

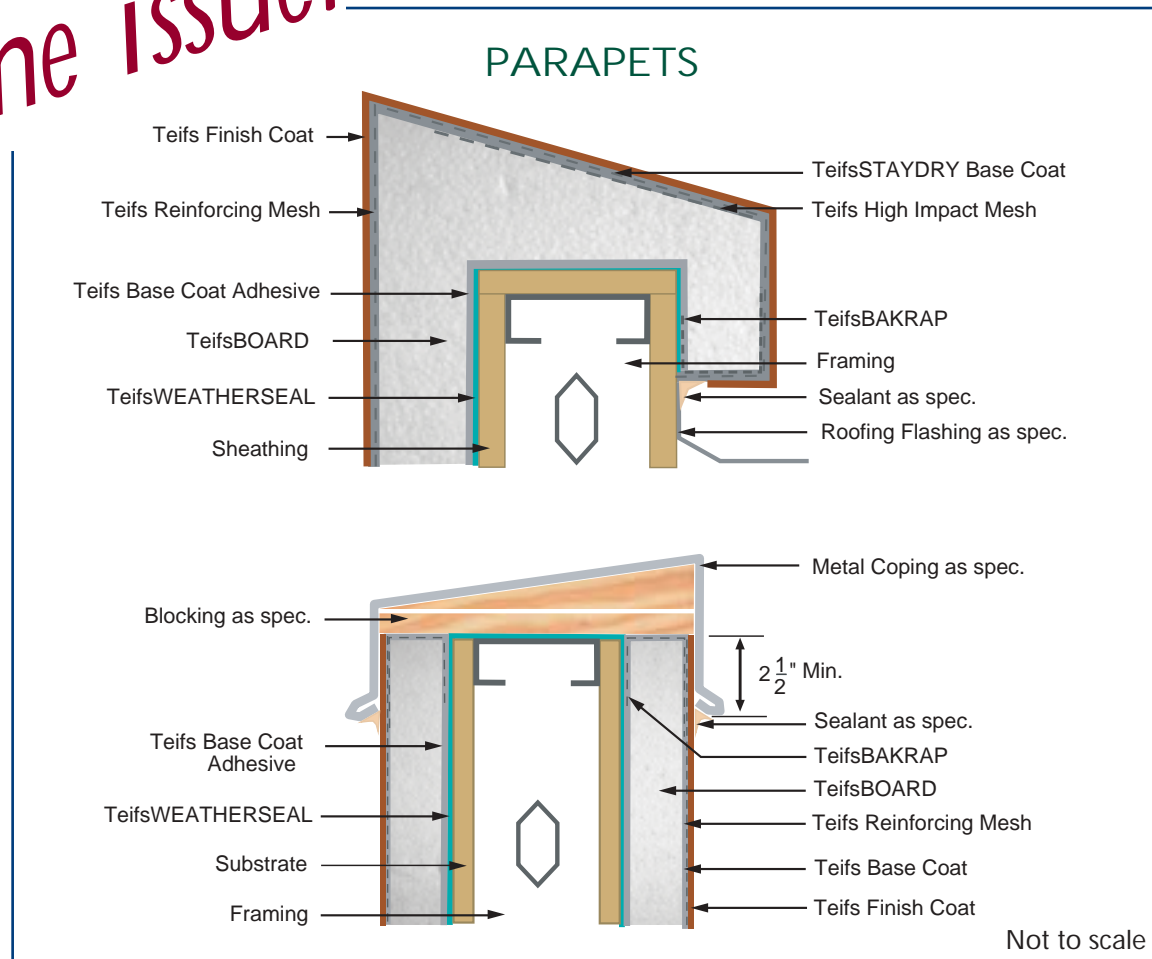

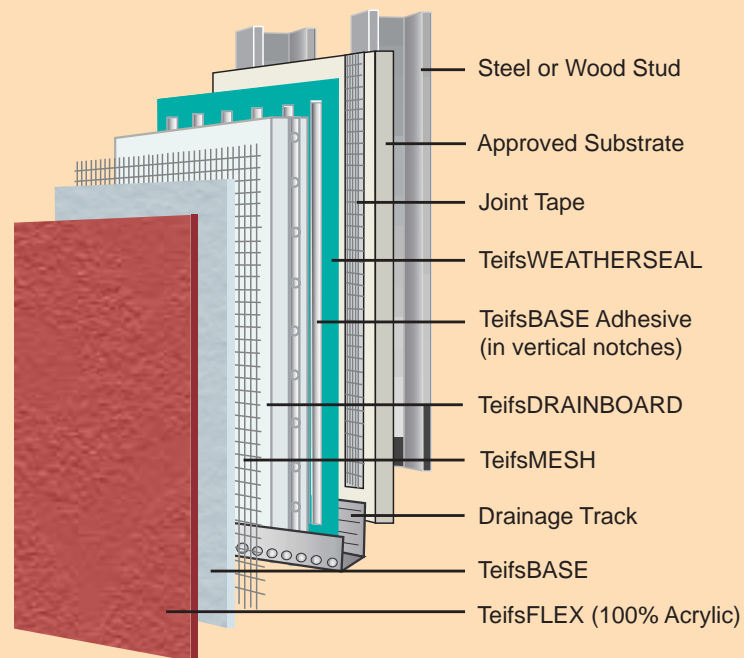
EIFS is not recommended as a horizontal (ROOFING) material and Teifs always recommends that the top of parapets be covered with a metal parapet cap with the metal cap flashing extending over the front and back face of the parapet walls a minimum of 2-1/2".

If a metal parapet cap is not possible, EIFS can be used with the following stipulations:

- A layer of high impact 20 ounce mesh is installed under the standard mesh on the flat upward surfaces
- TeifsSTAYDRY Waterproof base coat is used as the base coat material
- The sheathing under the parapet is protected with a waterproofing material such as TeifsWEATHERSEAL
